# Nassau Region PTA Carolyn Fiori Leadership Award

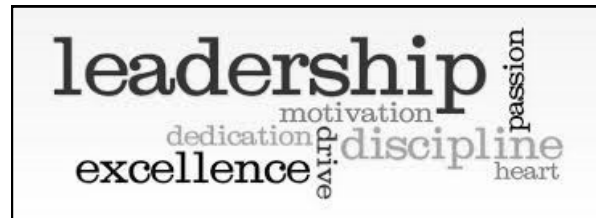
## CRITERIA
